Posso was born in the back of beyond, just this side of Bullamakanka. He earned his stripes in Melbourne, as an enforcer at a posh St Kilda 'gentlemens' club'. The young man always did like a flutter, and when one particular bookie became too insistent over a trifling sum, Posso fled the city for a fresh start in the Big Smoke.

Posso is now an outer ('legit') member of the Choker's Lane Push, and has recently been given management of the Black Star as part of Marina Shroud's campaign to control the Cross. From the club, Posso attends to the entertainment needs of VIP clientele—pollies and beaks and coppers and bunyip aristocracy—recording

the details in his little black notebook. From his office at the Star, he also directs large parts of the local drug trade.

Posso is in out of his depth, and he knows it.

Gangsters like Red Sven and the Ratcatcher really run the Star, the girls, and the drugs, while Posso is merely the front man set up to take the heat. The daily brutality of the gangs sickens him. An all-out war between Tilley Devine and Marina Shrouds is brewing, and Posso knows he will be in the front line.

He wants out, but he's trapped.

Something big is going down. Strange people come to the Black Star at all hours. Weird, mumbo-jumbo gypsy types, all black veils and turbans and capes. It's a real freak show. And they're straight to Red's office.

The panic attacks are becoming more frequent. You don't sleep, you vomit each night before entering the Black Star. You feel like you're having a heart attack.

You keep it to yourself of course. You need to be strong.

NO LN(AIN, MOBBIE?

Posso is an attentive host to the Brooks' investigator guests. On Shrouds' direction, he has a newly-awakened interest in greater mysteries, and can be persistent in his questions about the occult and the reality of magic. Sometimes it's as though he's taking notes. Playing guide gets him away from the Star, and Posso is finding the entire occult jaunt fascinating.

Posso is a sharp dresser and womaniser, manipulative, and vain. He will flirt with anything on legs, including (to Bettie's jealous ire) young Merrin Brook. He is hopelessly addicted to gambling (his losses paid out for now using club funds) and has a steadily escalating drug habit.

Posso has introduced both Bettie Brook and Cyrus Browne to the darker pleasures of the night.

U COOD ECC

Being with Bettie has its ups and downs, but at the moment she is Posso's only source of strength.

If he thought about it (and he doesn't) Posso might realise he gives Betty the freedom to be who she is. He never judges her. She needs that. Betty takes things too seriously, and Posso needs to remind her that sometimes you just start again. The past is past. Forget it.

Yet it is a dangerous time. They may both be engulfed

Posso feels like a drowning man.

His name is Gerald. He is afraid.

Gerald wants to back a winner. He wants to survive to collect his winnings.
